Kayaking between **Icebergs**





Kayak between the icebergs of Grey lake and descent of Grey river

Half day Paine river

The excursion begins in the narrowness of Paine river near the Explora hotel in direction to the salto chico, privileged place with an exceptional view of Los Cuernos. After capturing this special view from our kayaks we start the smooth descent of the Paine river, paddling under the Weber bridge and entering into the Toro lake where we will end our navigation near the Administration of the National Park.

Half day icebergs of Grey lake

The excursion takes place in the Grey peninsula sector where the icebergs accumulate. The passengers will be kayaking between icebergs that have detached from the wall of the Grey glacier and have travelled 18 kilometers with the wind across the lake toward the peninsula where they will finally melt after 12 thousand years.

Half day Grey river

The excursion takes place in the Grey river from where it originates in the lake down to the Grey bridge going through a canyon that protects the kayakers from the wind, guaranteeing a tranquil adventure even if other activities in the park may suspend due to the unpredictable climate of Patagonia.

Icebergs and Grey lake Full day kayak

The full day kayak icebergs and Grey river begins at the operation base Rutaspatagonia in the Serrano river sector where the passengers need to show up on their own account in the morning until 10:00 am to receive their personal equipment, paddling instructions and a safety talk. It includes a box lunch with three options: vegetarian, red meat and chicken.

Passengers must choose from these options the night before the excursion. Although previous experience and exceptional physical condition are not necessary to participate in this full-day experience, adventurers must sacrifice a little bit for the privilege of approaching the detached ice of Grey glacier and paddledown the pristine waters of the Grey river.

The excursion will end at the operation base at Serrano river sector, where participants have access to the furnished cabin, private camping site and changing rooms. We include the transfer to the park headquarters once the program ends.

General conditions

Touristic activities in the Grey lake

- No trip will be cancelled because of adverse weather conditions but there could be modifications on the itinerary made by the guide to guarantee the passengers safety and enjoyment.
- All of the reservations must come with the following information: Name and Surname, Passport number, Nationality, Birth date, Height, Weight, Medical restrictions and Food preferences. They must also indicate where are they spending the night.
- Hour of presentation at Rutaspatagonia's operation base until 10:00 hrs. (A.M. Programs).
- Hour of presentation at Rutaspatagonia's operation base until 14:00 hrs. (P.M. Programs).
- The excursion activates a personal insurance for adventure activities.
- One guide will go with a maximum of 4 passengers.
- The maximum of people in an excursion will be 24 passengers and 6 guides
- The excursion includes the following equipment for passengers and guides: safety and technical equipment for navigation programs (single and double kayaks, paddles, spray skirts, water pumps, rescue and tow line, flare signals, dry bags, water-resistant jacket, life jacket (PFD), neoprene wet suit, booties and poagies.
- Transportation service R/T Operation base – Grey lake
- Prices in dollars will only be modified with a negative modification in the exchange rate.
- Payment with credit card, we charge 3% extra from the normal price

The programs include

- Complete personal equipment (water-resistant jacket, neoprene wet suit, booties and poagies, life jacket (PFD) and dry bags).
- Bilingual specialized kayak guides.
- VHF radio communication equipment and protocol.
- First Aid Kit and assistance protocol.
- Rescue equipment and evacuation protocol.
- Box lunch and hot drinks for full day programs.
- Transportation R/T Operation base – Grey lake.
- Personal insurance for adventure activities.
